



May 6, 2026 | Judges Rule Against Section 122 Tariffs

On May 6, a Court of International Trade panel [ruled against](#) President Trump's 10% Section 122, "balance-of-payments" tariffs. The 2-1 decision applies only to shipments for which the importers who brought the suit are the importers of record and does not impose a universal injunction on the duties. Therefore, Section 122 tariffs will remain in place while the case is appealed to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit.

MICA will continue to monitor this case as it moves through appeals.
