## June 6, 2026 | Overweight Restrictions Impacting Cargo Through Los Angeles and Long Beach

**MICA has recently become aware of potential issues involving a container weights moving through the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach.** Early reports suggest that some containers may be experiencing difficulties even when exceeding weight thresholds by only a few hundred pounds.

Members shipping cargo through Southern California ports should **review shipment weights carefully** and remain alert to any operational challenges that may arise. At this time, the full scope of the issue is still being assessed.

MICA is actively gathering additional information and will provide further updates, guidance, and hopefully points of contacts, and general guidance as more details become available.
